Career Events

FALL 2006 CAREER ORIENTATION SESSION

Fall 2006 Career Orientation session took place on November 22&23. Since 1999, this session was conceived by the Career Orientation Office to help students know their professional interests and formulate their career projects while familiarizing them with the different techniques of recruitment and initiating them to interview situations. It is constituted of three major components: personal interest surveys, tips on how to succeed a job search, CV & cover letter writing workshops and job interviews simulations. Fall 2006 Career Orientation was monitored by **Ms. Nadia Iraki Laalaj, Human Resources Expert**, who administrated the tests, namely personality, profile & talent tests. This led to "*le Bilan de la Personnalité*" followed by *Motivation tests* and *the professional project*. **The CV & Motivation Letter** were presented as **personalized tools to Market one's profile**. Participants had to prepare their CVs that were corrected by Mrs. Laalaj, submitted and discussed with each participant. Throughout the session, Ms. Laalaj stressed the importance of *doing a self-evaluation* and *motivation exercise* and getting informed (through internet, the alumni network...) about companies targeted in *formulating a good professional project*.

AIESEC TRAININGS:

The second training session of AIESEC took place on November 10& 11. This extensive training program was Supervise by Mr. Naoufel Testaouni, president of AIESEC in Morocco. It was a chance for AIESEC

members to know each other. The training session was an overview about AIESEC history, structure, learning environment, and the basic level of the exchange process (trainees coming to Morocco and students going abroad). The trainer also made members know well about the AIESEC's information system; he explained the objective and the process of the Market research. This was the first day training program. The second day training objective was to make members aware about the AIESEC structure (executive board, active members, etc) and their roles in order to join a committee and begin acting. Both trainings lasted for about two hours each. Members were more motivated than in the first training. Another training will take place in a couple of weeks before the conference scheduled in December.

AIESEC NATIONAL Conference

AIESEC organizes its yearly national seminar of motivation and training (SNMF) in order to familiarize and integrate new members in AIESEC atmosphere. This reunion will be in order to have more details about the AIESEC mission, vision, role, and values which will lead to the next step that is "taking responsibility." This seminar will take place on December 1, 2, & 3 in the CNSS club in Mohammadia. Participation fees of the seminar are 350 DHs (complete accommodation).
