The scholarships will meet the costs of university course fees, travel, establishment in Australia, and living expenses for up to 12 months' study.

CAAR was established by the Australian Government in January 2003 to strengthen ties between Australia and Arab countries. The Council's role is to promote greater understanding and acceptance of Australian and Arab cultures, values, beliefs and diversity. The focus is on commercial and people-to-people links and it also works to strengthen academic and educational ties.
